

Guidance for Submitting Papers and Extended Abstracts

2005 Coastal Cutthroat Trout Symposium:

Biology, Status, Management, and Conservation

29 September – 1 October 2005

Fort Worden State Park, Port Townsend, Washington

Submission Deadline: 12 September 2005

The deadline for submitting papers and extended abstracts for the 2005 Coastal Cutthroat Trout Symposium is **Monday, 12 September 2005**. Submissions must be sent via email in an attached MS Word (*.doc) file to: patrick_connolly@usgs.gov

There are two publications planned to result for this Symposium: A Symposium Proceedings (similar to the 1995 SeaRun Cutthroat Trout Symposium Proceedings) will include papers and extended abstracts for papers and posters presented at the Symposium. In addition, a collection of submissions will be selected by the Editorial Committee to be included in a collection of manuscripts to be submitted to the North American Journal of Fisheries Management (journal subject to change). Authors wishing to have their submission considered for inclusion in the journal collection should clearly indicate their interest upon submittal of the manuscript. Authors submitting manuscripts for consideration for journal publication must submit **both** an extended abstract (for the Symposium Proceedings if the manuscript is selected for publication) and a full manuscript (in the event the submission is not selected for journal publication). All submissions will go through peer review. Please note that submissions for journal publication will be subject to a more rigorous peer review and selection process, and must meet the editorial policy and guidelines of the journal.

Our goal is to have the proceedings available as quickly as possible after the Symposium. To meet this goal, we will be enlisting Symposium authors as peer reviewers for the proceedings.

Manuscript Preparation

The format for all submissions should follow that of the North American Journal of Fisheries Management of the American Fisheries Society (<http://www.fisheries.org/html/publications/journals/authguides.shtml>).

Submissions should include:

1. Lead author contact information
2. Attached MS Word (*.doc) file in NAJFM manuscript format
3. Indicate if manuscript should be considered for journal publication
